Thinking process	Focuses on people Outward looking. Open minded, seeking new possibilities and positive relationships	Focuses on tasks or activities Inward looking. Primarily concerned about what's within their control or immediate remit
Goal setting	Thinks about the bigger picture – not afraid to be creative  Looks at the future of the club and considers what might be possible	Works on tasks and plans  Looks at improving the present and what's happening in the here and now

Managing relationships	Empowers colleagues and team members  Trusts people to do a good job  Creates and identifies development opportunities  Spots and encourages potential	Directs colleagues and team members  Co-ordinates activity  Gives feedback about individual's contribution and performance
Operation	Creates and drives change  Does the right things  Supports colleagues and team members in the process	Does things right – follows process  Manages change  Supports leaders
Governance	Uses the power of positive influence  Manages conflict to achieve a positive outcome  Acts decisively and confidently	Uses authority Avoids conflict Acts responsibly
